There is no significance to which spot you put the player's name in. Whether he's first, last or in between, he'll get one point for being on your list.

If you didn't send five names before, don't worry. Now is your chance to join in. If you sent five names before, be sure to list them again. We're not going to search for your previous ballot if you write "and the five I said before."

Remember, you must be a member of PFRA to vote, and you must sign your ballot.

All NFL years 1920-thru-1959 are available plus the 1926 AFL and the 1946-49 AAFC. Each lists the date, place, score by quarters, individual scoring, and in most cases the announced attendance.

Game summaries are included in the following: NFL 1920-34, 1939, 1950-59, 1926 AFL, and 1946 AAFC. Other summaries will be added if members care to write them.
